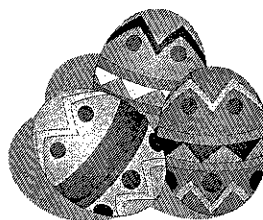


March Newsletter 2018

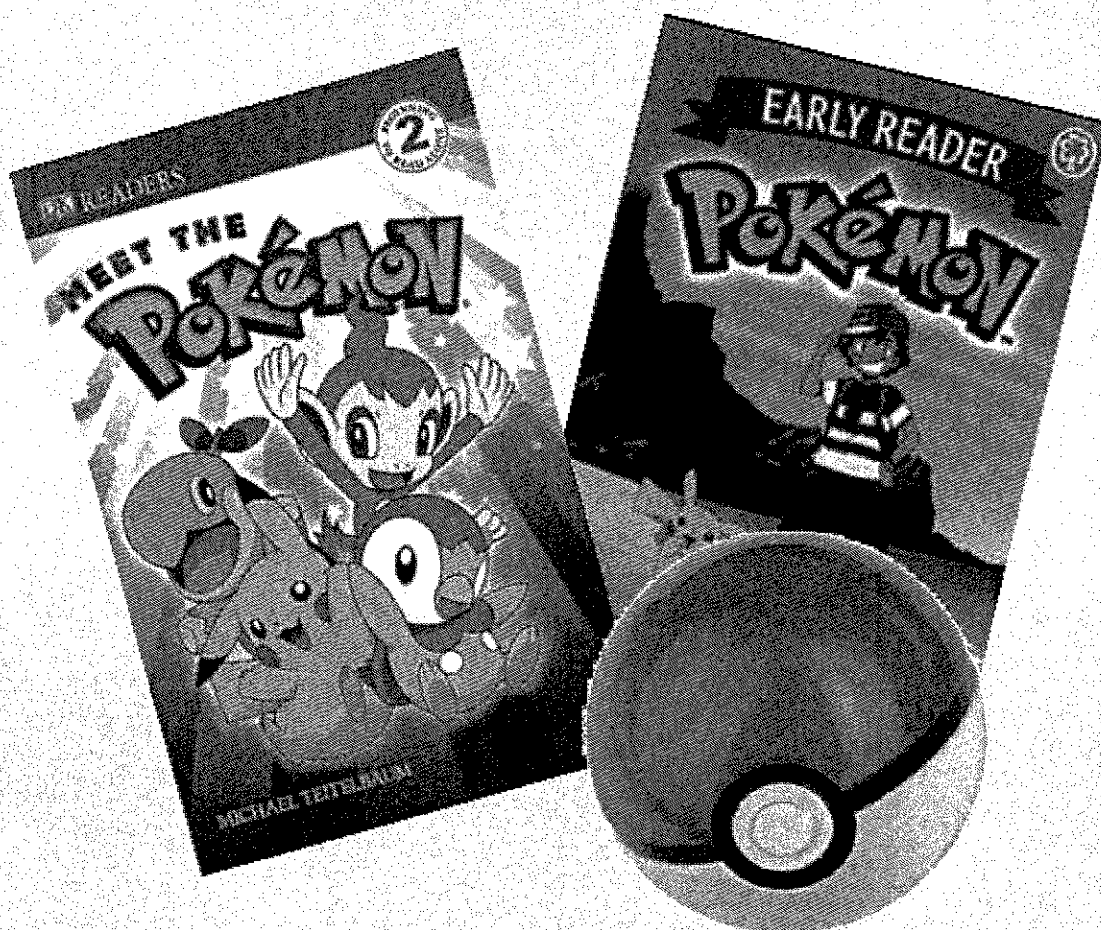

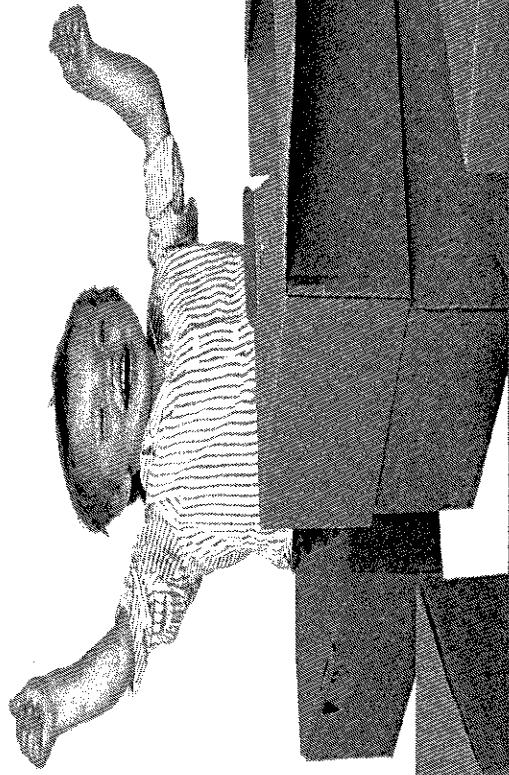
