# Online Home Learning Lockdown January 2021

Throughout lockdown 3 we will be providing your child with online learning. This learning will be in a variety of forms such as Purple Mash, Google Classrooms and a variety of other learning platforms.

There will be one teacher in each phase who will be your contact point and in EYFS both teachers will be able to support you. All other teachers will be teaching classes through the week, so please make sure that you only contact the teachers in charge of online home learning.

#### How long can I expect work set by the school to take my child each day?

In EYFS, KS1 and KS2 work set by the school should take approximately 3 hours a day.

### How will your child access online remote learning?

We recognise that some pupils may not have technology required to access learning online. In this case the school may be able to provide a laptop to support online learning. Please contact the school office in this case.

## What should I expect from school?

#### **EYFS**

In EYFS remote learning will be sent daily through the Evidence Me App. There will be daily maths, literacy and phonics activities as well as a mixture of PSE, Physical, Understanding the World and Expressive Arts and Design activities across the week. These activities will mirror, as closely as possible, what is happening in school based lessons for EYFS. The activities will be a mixture of tutorial videos from Oak National Academy, worksheets, reading links and phonic links and practical activities. Parents are asked to upload evidence of the work their child has completed onto the Evidence Me App.

**KS1:** A daily timetable will be added to the Lower School Phase Webpage beginning on Thursday 7th January. http://www.hollandhavenschool.co.uk/lower-school-year-1-and-2.html Please check this daily.

This timetable will contain activities that mirror, as closely as possible, what is happening in school based lessons for KS1. The activities will be a mixture of Purple Mash, TT Rockstars, RM Maths, tutorial videos or links, worksheets, reading links, phonic links and where possible the actual lessons delivered in school.

#### KS<sub>2</sub>

A Middle School Google Classroom and an Upper School Google Classroom will be set up from Thursday 7th January and your children will receive an email to their school GMail account (details in little red homework book) inviting them to join the classroom. A daily timetable will be added to the Google Classroom each day, along with the learning resources and activities needed. This timetable will direct your child to the learning platforms when required (e.g. MyMaths, Reading Plus/Lexia, Times Table Rockstars, Purple Mash, Real PE).

### Engagement and feedback.

The five phase leaders, who are responsible for remote learning, will respond to work that is submitted by pupils in a range of ways such as written comments, emails and phone calls/Zoom meetings. Children at home are involved in the weekly reward system of effort certificates which will be posted home on a weekly basis.

## Additional support with pupils with particular needs.

We recognise that some pupils, for examples pupils with special educational needs and disabilities (SEND), may not be able to access remote education without support from adults at home. We acknowledge the difficulties this may place on families, and we will work with parents and carers to support those pupils by phone calls, email contact, zoom meetings, family liaison, pastoral support and SENCo support.

## Remote education for self isolating pupils.

Pupils who are self isolating will follow the above remote learning offer.

# Monitoring remote earning and engagement.

Over the course of the lockdown, we will monitor your child's engagement with our remote learning offer. If your child is not engaging, we will call you to see if we can support you further. The five phase leaders will keep a weekly record of your child's engagement.
