#### **COVID TESTS**

Please can I remind you that a Lateral Flow Test is not the test that can be used when a person has symptoms of COVID. If your child has any of the COVID symptoms they **MUST** take a PCR test. If your child takes a PCR test, we will need to see evidence of the result before your child returns to school.
