Curriculum threads: environmental sustainability, responsibility, and various aspects of personal and social development (subjects, including PSHE, history, geography, science...)

Integration of Themes: The curriculum integrates themes such as environmental responsibility, diversity, and well-being across various subjects. This interdisciplinary approach helps students see the connections between different areas of knowledge.

Practical Activities: The inclusion of practical activities, such as beach trips, fieldwork, and hands-on experiences, enhances students' understanding and engagement with the themes. It allows for experiential and embodied learning.

Critical Thinking: The curriculum involves critical thinking and philosophical discussions (e.g., Philosophy for Children - P4C - sessions and Thinking Classrooms - Challenge 10 tools etc). This is valuable for developing students' analytical skills and encouraging them to think deeply about ethical and societal issues.

Cultural and Historical Context: The inclusion of historical figures, cultural aspects, and exploration of different time periods enriches students' understanding of the world and its diverse history.

Global Awareness: Curriculum designed to promote global perspective, exploring different countries, cultures, and issues. This contributes to fostering global awareness and a sense of responsibility towards the broader world. [Link to Ghanaian primary school and pupils.](#)
